MATTERS ARISING

Update on Beneficial Ownership Disclosure Regime for Ghana

- The secretariat to send an email to members of the MSG to provide their comments and or inputs to help finalize the draft report.
- Draft report on consultation workshop to develop a road map on BO in Ghana should be shared with the international EITI Secretariat as a first and major step towards compliance of the requirement as well as to be posted on the GHEITI website.
- The Attorney General and the Registrar General, to send a justification to Parliament to enable the Companies Act to be amended under a Certificate of Urgency after the deliberation at the Dodowa Workshop
- GHEITI, OGP and the FIC are to hold meetings to solicit updates on the subject and more importantly set timelines to ensure achievement of results.
- The Secretariat to document the processes as part of the roadmap, and submit to the international EITI secretariat as part of efforts in getting a roadmap for Beneficial Ownership Disclosure

Production of 2015 EITI Report

- Avenues should be sought in response to the non-availability of funds. The Secretariat should seek clarification from the International EITI Secretariat to know the assistance they can give for the production of this report.
- Mrs. Philomena Johnson to look at the ToR to include the issues contained in the new EITI Standards and share with members of the MSG for their input.

Oil/Gas Commodity Trading Pilot Project

- The proposal should be amended to include mining companies and also include the jubilee partners and even private companies that buy our minerals.
- A comprehensive work plan/ program on the subject matter should be drawn and costed for submission to the International EITI Secretariat.
- Get expertise to come up with the scoping study and begin sensitization workshops on the matter.
- The Secretariat to organize a sensitization workshop for the media, Parliament, companies and the general public.

Media engagement on 2014 EITI reports

 The MSG/Secretariat to target particular media personalities or group who understand the issues and will give GHEITI activities the needed coverage.

Implementation of guidelines for the utilization of mineral royalties by MMDA's.

- Mrs. Philomena Johnson to submit to the GHEITI Secretariat the finalized work on the guidelines to share with the MSG for adoption.
- Meeting to be scheduled between the Minister (MLNR) and the MSG.

Dissemination of 2014 EITI Reports

The Secretariat to propose dates to the MSG for the dissemination activities.

Other Matters

- The Secretariat to organize a meeting for all the parties and also ensure that all parties are available or duly represented in the event that a member cannot make it.
- The Secretariat to schedule an Interactive meeting with ENI Ghana.
